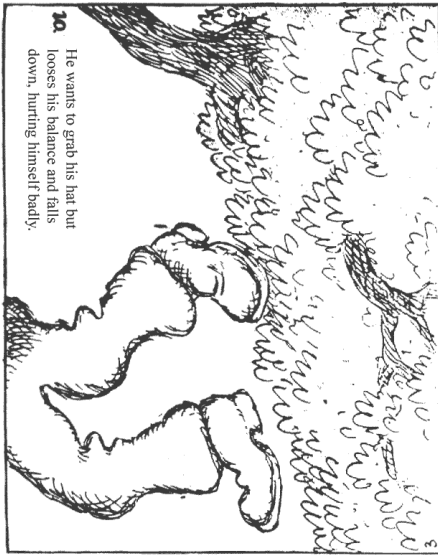
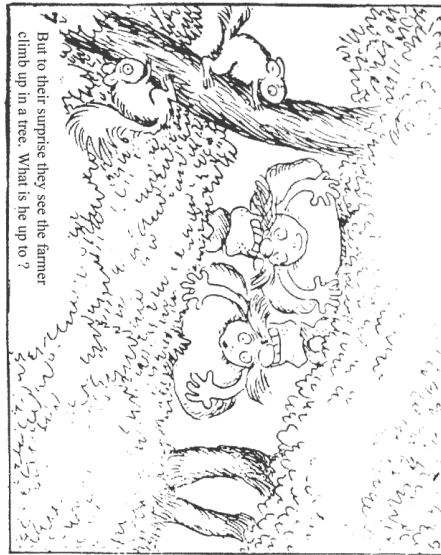


An Object Lesson for the Little Lady by Gustave Verbeek, 1904.

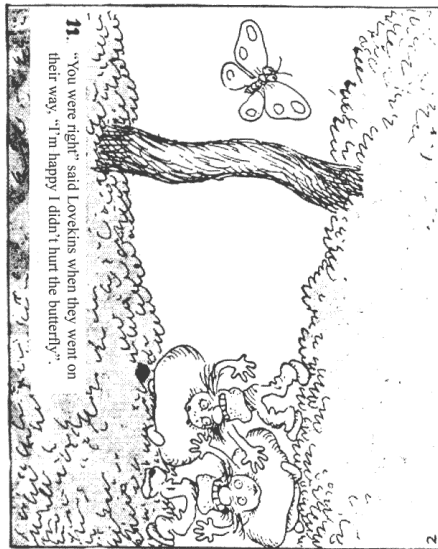
Turn the page to the right to read the first part, then turn it upside down to continue the story.



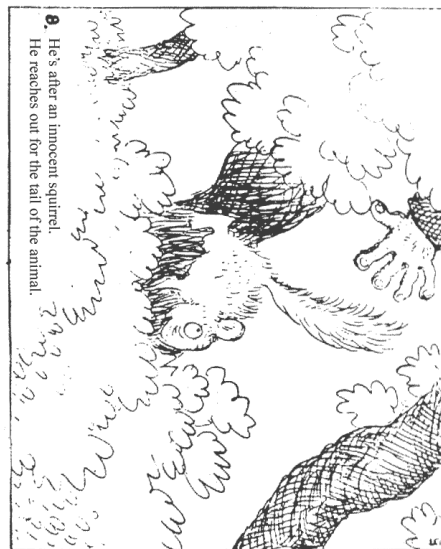
A little while later they see a clumsy peasant coming in their direction.



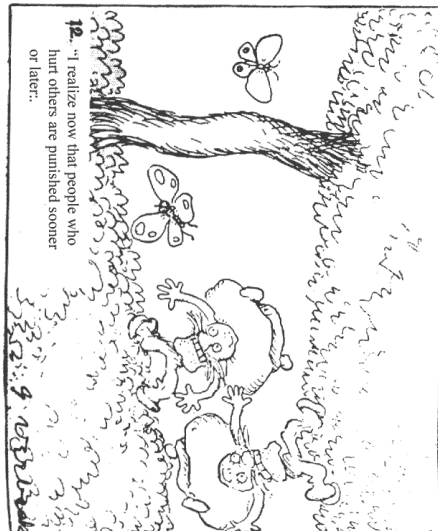
Muffaroo and Lovekins are watching him from a distance, quite amused.



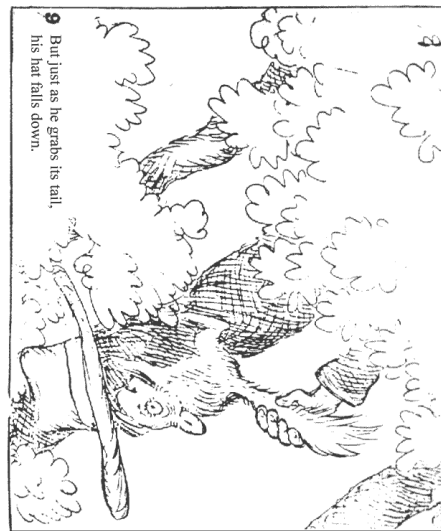
"Isn't there enough room on earth for you and that butterfly?" he asks. "Those who harm innocent creatures will be punished sooner or later".
